## Alley Clean-Up

The next Alley Clean-Up (after this month's) is scheduled to begin the first week in October. The Town is on a quarterly schedule. Pick-ups are: January, April, July and October.

The Town of Wellton established the Alley Clean-Up as a FREE service to aid the residents in any unusual hauling of very large items from their alleys. All small items or items that can be cut into smaller pieces should

be placed into your 90 gallon container for normal trash pick-up on Mondays and Thursdays.

Any items that are placed out for Alley Clean-Up should be bundled or bagged—except for the very large items. Loose grass clippings and such should be bagged and placed into your 90 gallon container. Yard trash, etc. should be bagged and placed into your 90 gallon container. ALL house trash, etc. should be placed into your 90 gallon container for normal trash pick-up. Please DO NOT overfill your 90 gallon container—it will spill when the trash truck dumps it. Place your container with the arrows facing towards the street.

The Town Staff picks up all burnable items first and then all the non-burnable. Please keep these separate to improve our pick-up time. If you have any questions about what can and cannot be picked up or to be put on the list—please call the Town Hall at 928-785-3348.
